Interactive, hands-on activities get high school students excited about career pathways in health care

- **What:** The Many Futures in Health Care Career Expo provides hands-on, interactive activities like surgical simulators, physical therapy tests, blood testing equipment and more to help nearly 600 high school students in Waukesha County learn about different career paths in health care.

Why: Most industries are facing a worker shortage, but the health care industry is facing that on top of an aging baby boomer population that will increase the demand for health care. According to the Waukesha-Ozaukee-Washington WOW Workforce Development Center, health care sectors in just those three counties will face an average employment increase of 16.2% by the year 2022, or an additional 13,000 workers. The goal of the career fair is to engage high school students, get them interested in health care careers and show them all the career paths available to them in the industry.
