ADVISORY COMMITTEES

EDUCATION STEERING

MEETS: FOURTH TUESDAY BIMONTHLY

The education steering committee develops, supports and promotes initiatives to ensure Waukesha County students are both college and career ready. This steering committee is supported by several action teams beneath it.

Requirements: Active member

LEADERSHIP

MEETS: SECOND WEDNESDAY MONTHLY
